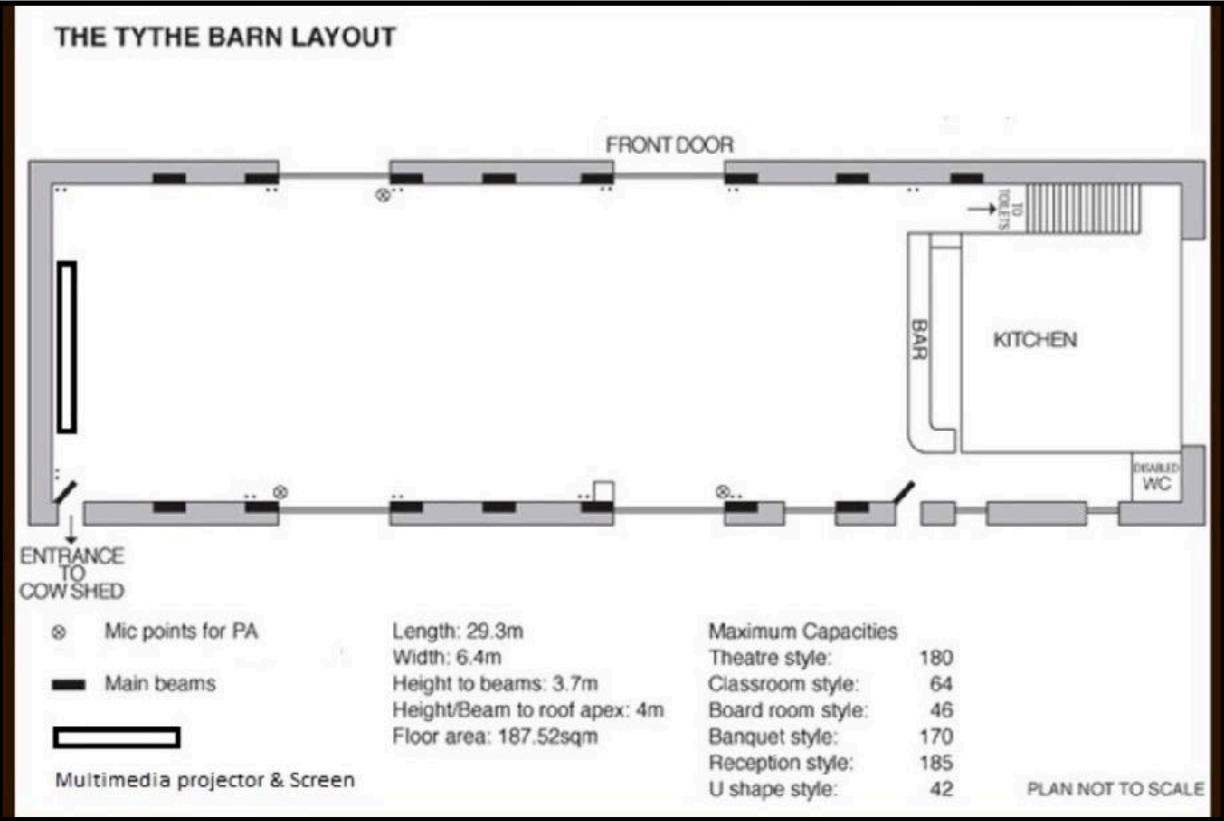

Tythe is located at the very heart of the Deeley farm and has been owned by the same family for over 500 years. The Thatched Barn

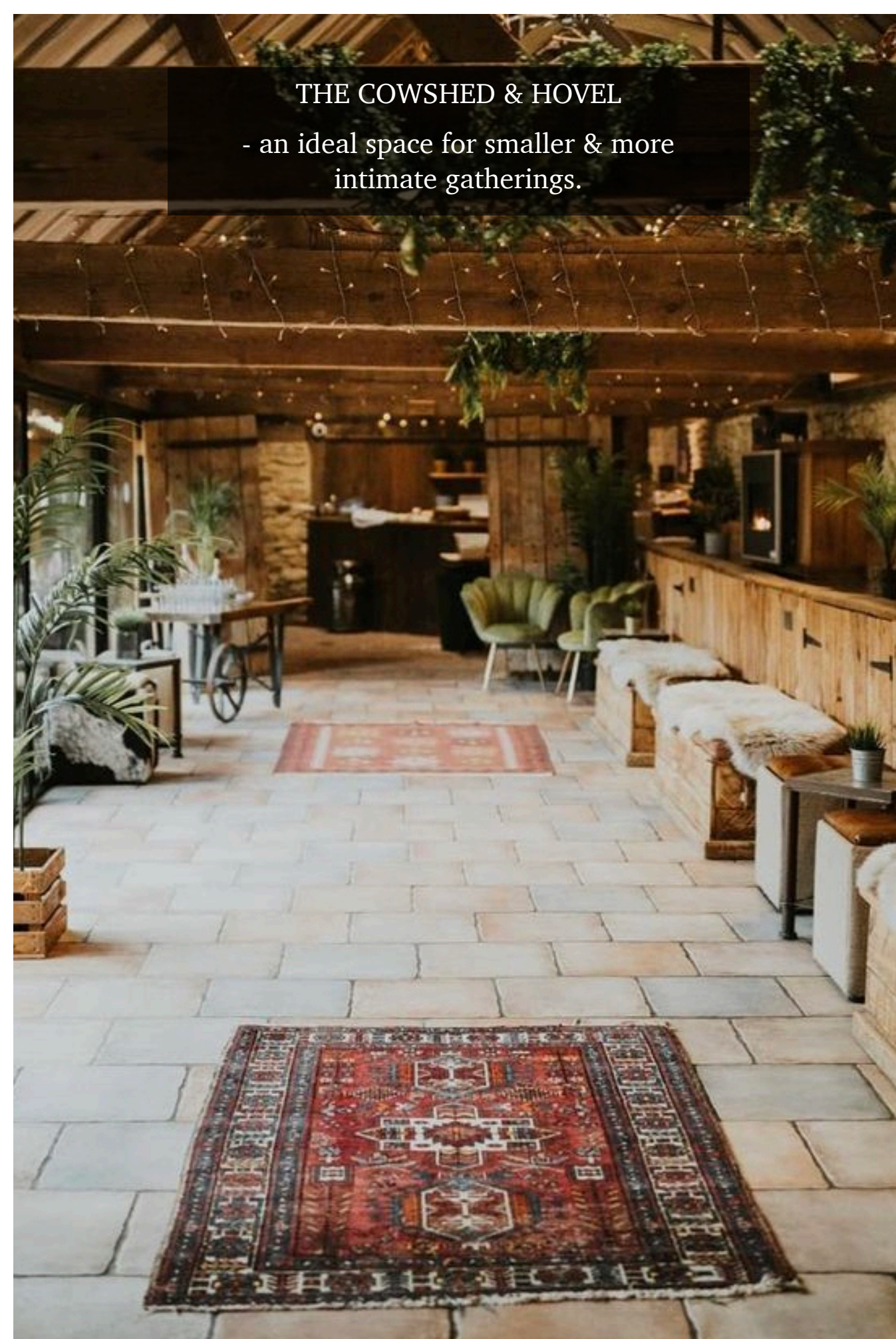
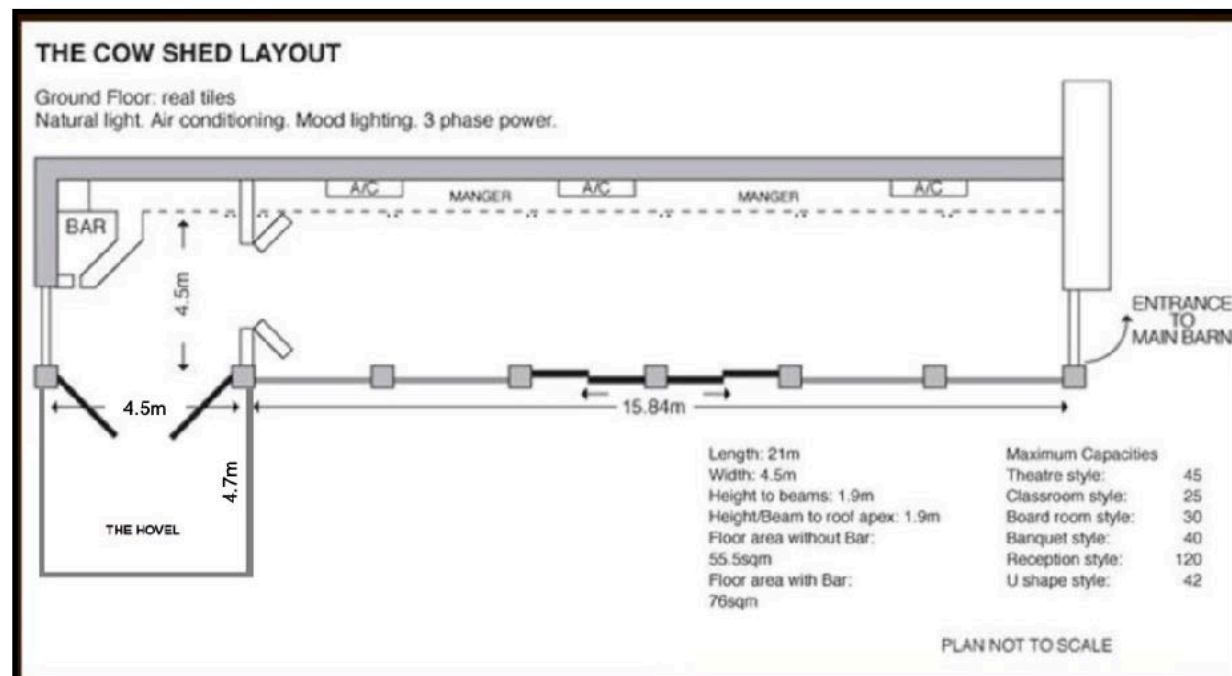

The Cowshed and Hovel

Adjoining The Thatched Barn, The Cowshed and The Hovel are more intimate spaces that can work together with, or independently from, The Thatched Barn. Incredibly adaptable – these barns feature timber beams, floor-to-ceiling glass and a combined 76sqm of space. Formerly an exposed area for animal feeding, The Cowshed has been transformed into a welcoming space for working and can accommodate a variety of seating layouts with maximum capacities of 45 for ‘theatre’ or 120 ‘reception’. Further options available. For more informal set ups or presentations, delegates can enjoy relaxed seating by the fires (and power sockets) and the use of a projector. In here you’ll also find the built-in pizza oven for some serious post-work grazing.

The far end of The Cowshed extends into The Hovel. Flexible and adaptable, this corner of Tythe allows you to work in the prettiest of settings against the backdrop of our impressive gardens. The Hovel can accommodate smaller meetings for up to eight (seated) or more if standing.

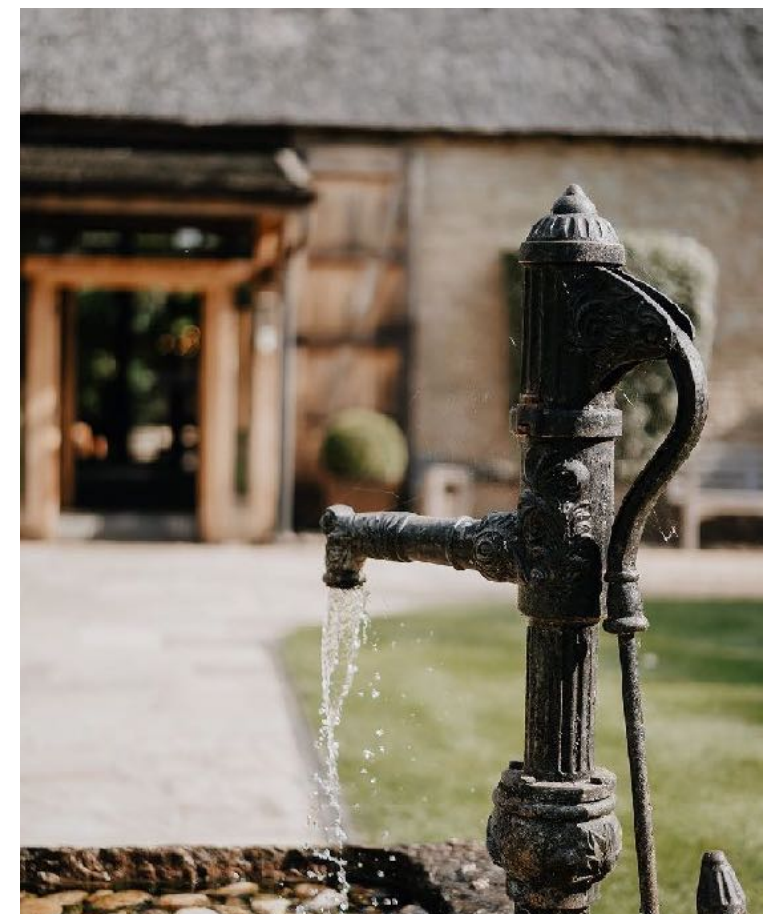
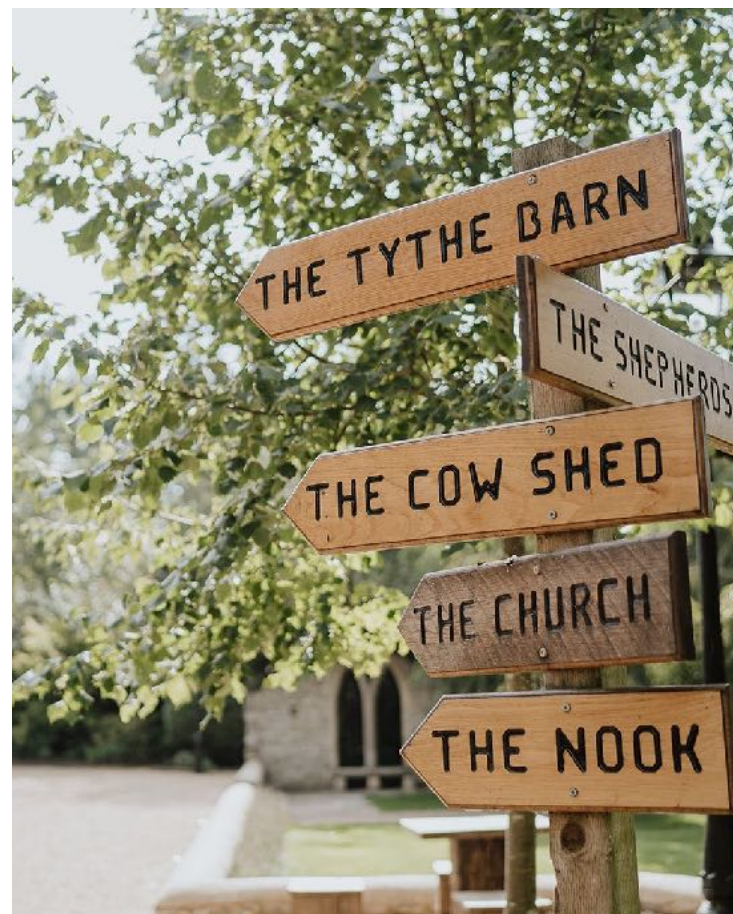
