






















### The Farmhouse

Located at the heart of Manor Farm and redesigned and re-imagined for our wedding guests, it now offers the perfect 'home from home' a stone's throw from Tythe's Thatched Barn, Cowshed, The Nook, The Lodge and gardens. The Farmhouse is offered exclusively to couples choosing to book Tythe for their wedding and is available for either a 1 or 2-night stay. Our wedding stays provide the wedding party with quality time together and an incredible wedding experience. The Farmhouse is surrounded by fields and sweeping lawns and the attention to detail and personal touches, that set us apart, are a subtle nod to the centuries spent as a much-loved family home. Boasting impressive interiors, that include a collection of carefully curated one-off pieces, the mood is informal, cosy and laid-back meaning guests will be feeling at home from the minute they enter through it's delightful cobblestone porch. Effortlessly stylish, we promise you and your guests a slice of something quintessentially English.



The 17th century manor house is referenced in the Domesday Book and offers seven double ensuite bedrooms, including a Master Wedding Suite and dedicated preparation room, two large reception rooms, dining room, garden room, country kitchen and open fires whilst outdoors sees a Shepherd's Hut sleeping two, tennis court and a wonderful wood-fuelled hot tub - all right next door to the Tythe Barn.













For Friday weddings, residents of The Farmhouse may arrive late afternoon on Thursday, enjoy the wedding day on Friday and depart Saturday. Our Saturday weddings begin with the bride's arrival at The Nook, in preparation for her wedding that day, followed by a day to do as you please at the house on the Sunday, departure Monday. Mid-week weddings arrive late Monday afternoon and depart on Wednesday morning.






























## Fearling










Our 14th Century, thatched-roof Tythe Barn provides the impressive backdrop for your Wedding Breakfast as well as some serious revelry later on. Sensitively brought into the 21st century and oozing a style and character all of its own, this stunning barn has played an integral part of our family farm for over 400 years. Having been sympathetically restored and carefully adapted it for it's new role, much of the original building still stands today and still boasts every ounce of its historical charm.



### Every bite deserves a magical backdrop - tuck in to Tythe's quirky selection of props!

Tythe allows couples to get creative and have fun with their feasting whilst soaking up the diverse surroundings of the Tythe estate. Tythe is set at the heart of our family's working farm and farming has always been about re-purposing what you have around you - our salvaged props are testament to this. Treat resident house guests to an arrival supper or BBQ brunch from the converted Sheep Feeder or a selection of post-wedding drinks and nibbles from our 'straw bale' bar set beneath the Willow tree. On a wedding day greet guests with pre-ceremony drinks from our 1973 Landrover whilst our old wooden carts serve as rustic tea and coffee stations or as vintage props for post-dinner cocktails. Later in the evening guests can graze on wood-fired pizzas, served on crafted timber boards, by the outdoor wood-burners. When it's time to sweeten the mood - think delicious sweets encased in glass baubles, suspended from our London Plain trees or our rustic log piled high with indulgent and irresistibly rich donuts. At Tythe we're all about treating your guests to exquisite food... with an added touch of magic!



# Late Afternoon, games and The Party

Pull up a deckchair, impress the party with your 'Connect Four' prowess or snuggle up on a sheepskin-clad pew by the outdoor wood-burners and indulge in a post-feast tipple - our Espresso Martinis are seriously good!

Drinks

**Q**. Do you offer a 'no-fee' corkage option?

A. Yes. Tythe is pleased to offer couples a no-fee corkage option for their Wedding Breakfast drinks. This is applicable for the Wedding Breakfast only and allows couples the opportunity to provide their own Wines, Bubbly and Champagne for the dinner. This based upon a maximum of 100 guests. (A surcharge of £18 per person applies to any guests above this number).

**Q**. Do you offer an extensive Drinks List?

**A.** Absolutely. Tythe has put together a carefully curated Wine List to compliment our menus and is happy to supply all alcohol for your wedding day. Tythe also has a well-stocked bar with a good selection of wines, spirits, lagers, ale and soft drinks. We love to support local vineyards and distilleries and have a number of locally made Gins, Ales and wines to choose from.

**Q**. Does Tythe offer 'Drinks Packages'?

A. Yes we do! Tythe offers both 'Farmhouse Drinks Packages' and 'Wedding Day Drinks Packages' allowing couples to choose a selection of drinks that suit both their wedding day and their budget!

**Q**. Can we organise cocktails, a cocktail hour or cocktail station?

**A.** Of course! Not only can couples select from our comprehensive library of popular cocktails but couples may choose to create a bespoke cocktail with support from our in-house Mixologist and, if available, use fresh seasonal ingredients from Tythe's orchard and kitchen garden.

**Q**. Does Tythe offer a selection of props to display drinks?

**A.** Indeed! Looking for a stylish backdrop to stage those Espresso Martinis or Aperol Spritz? Tythe has a seriously cool 'insta-worthy' collection of charming pieces including vintage carts, a horse box, straw bale bar, antique dressers and even a 1973 Landrover!

**Q**. Is there a minimum spend on drinks?

**A.** Yes. We have a minimum evening bar spend set at £1,000 for our midweek weddings and £1,500 for weekend weddings. The minimum bar spend applies to any drinks 'post' Wedding Breakfast and speeches, ie -drinks consumed once the couple and their guests have left the dining tables. Preordered cocktails can be included within the evening's min bar spend.
















