The Farmhouse Bedrooms

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Each bedroom at The Farmhouse has it's own personality - pick your favourite! All bedrooms are ensuite with King or Super King beds, 400-thread cotton bed linen and our luxurious pillow top mattresses - handcrafted with sustainable, breathable fibres and up to two fleeces of wool traceable to British farms.

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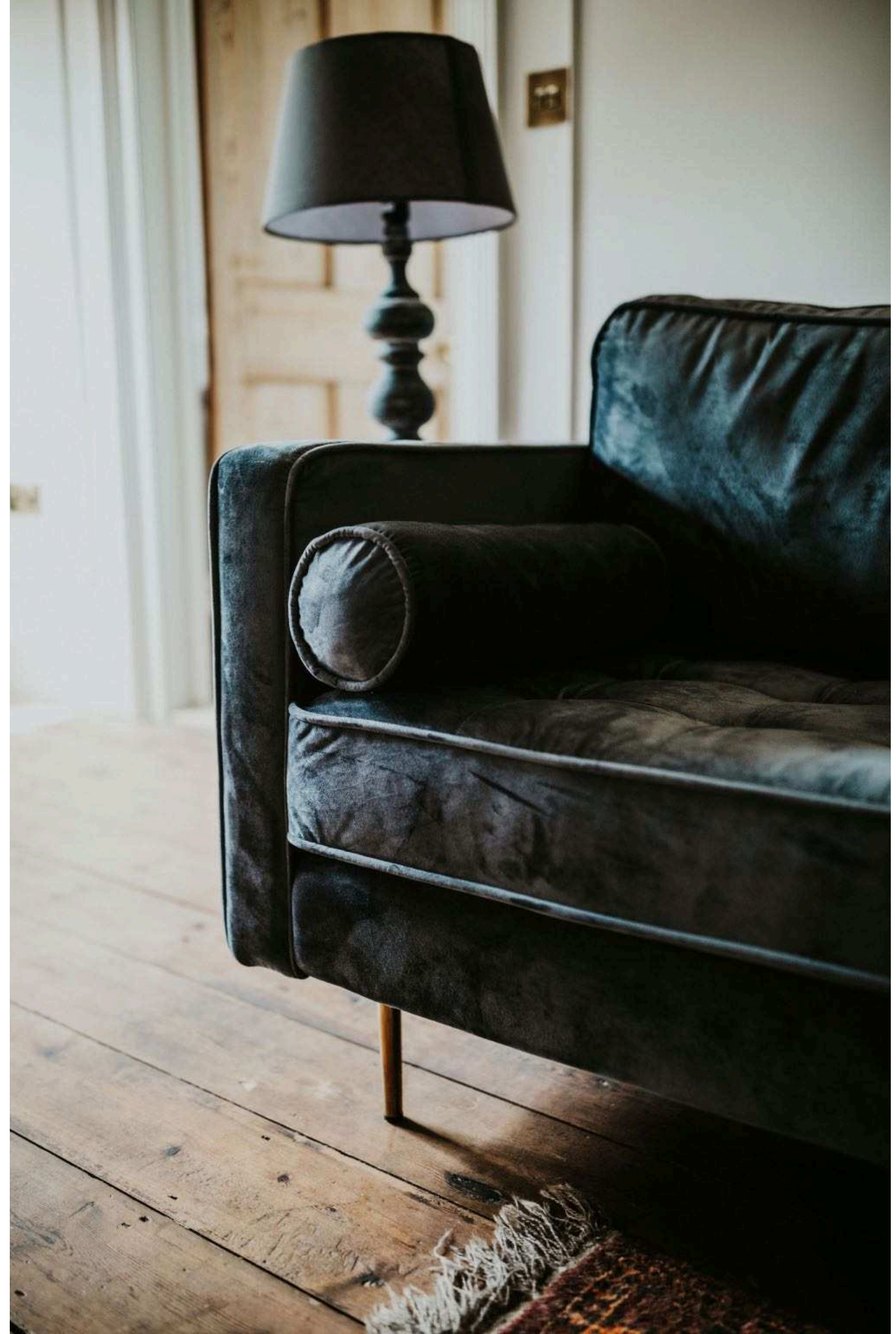
For your comfort and convenience each bedroom, within The Farmhouse, benefits from bedside tables and reading lamps, dressing table and mirror, T.V, clothes storage and hangers, tea/coffee trays, kettle, hairdryer, full length mirror, safe, bin and additional seating. Some bedrooms have the option to convert to twin beds and space for an extra 'put up' bed.

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The Farmhouse bedrooms all have their own adjoining en-suite bathroom with either bath or shower. Please note - the en-suite to The Wheat Room is across the hall and guests staying in The Barley Room have 4 steps up to their en-suite.

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The luxurious bathrooms are all individually designed with quality fittings and finishes and offer complimentary amenities by locals Plum & Ashby. Each bathroom is also equipped with a selection of soft, fluffy towels as well as our cosy, white robes.



The Apple Loft

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The largest bedroom in the house with an enormous en-suite that boasts a gorgeous freestanding roll-top copper bathtub and two-person shower! Perfect as the Master or Wedding Suite!

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Adjacent to the Dressing Room and Champagne Bar - The Apple Loft is located at the far east end of the house and boasts it's own impressive spiral staircase that leads to or from the magnificent kitchen/dining room.

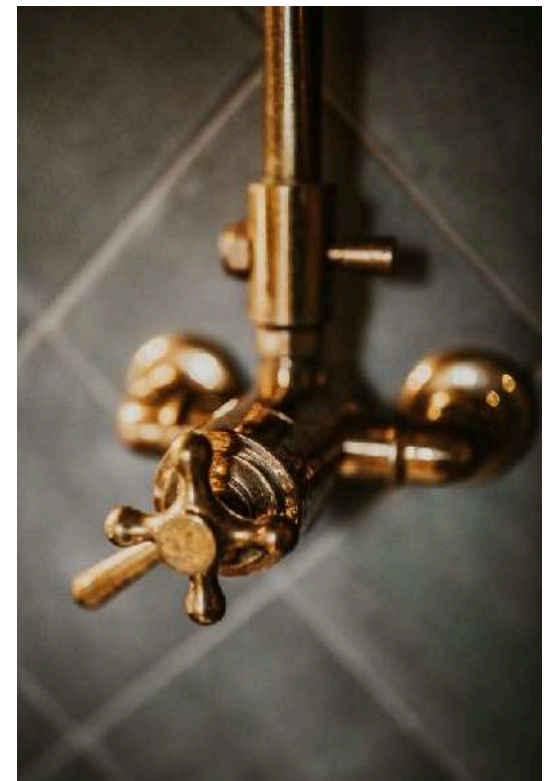
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Gorgeous views of the gardens, tennis court and 12th Century church next door. Timber beams above add charm and character whilst under-floor heating provides extra warmth!

The Apple Loft

The Wheat Room

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Large double room, overlooking the gardens and located closest to The Apple Loft and Dressing Room. The Wheat Room is light and spacious and can accommodate an additional 'put-up' bed with the option to also convert to a twin bedded room.

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The Wheat Room features beautiful William Morris wallpaper and a vintage velvet sofa, built-in wardrobes and a quirky window seat.

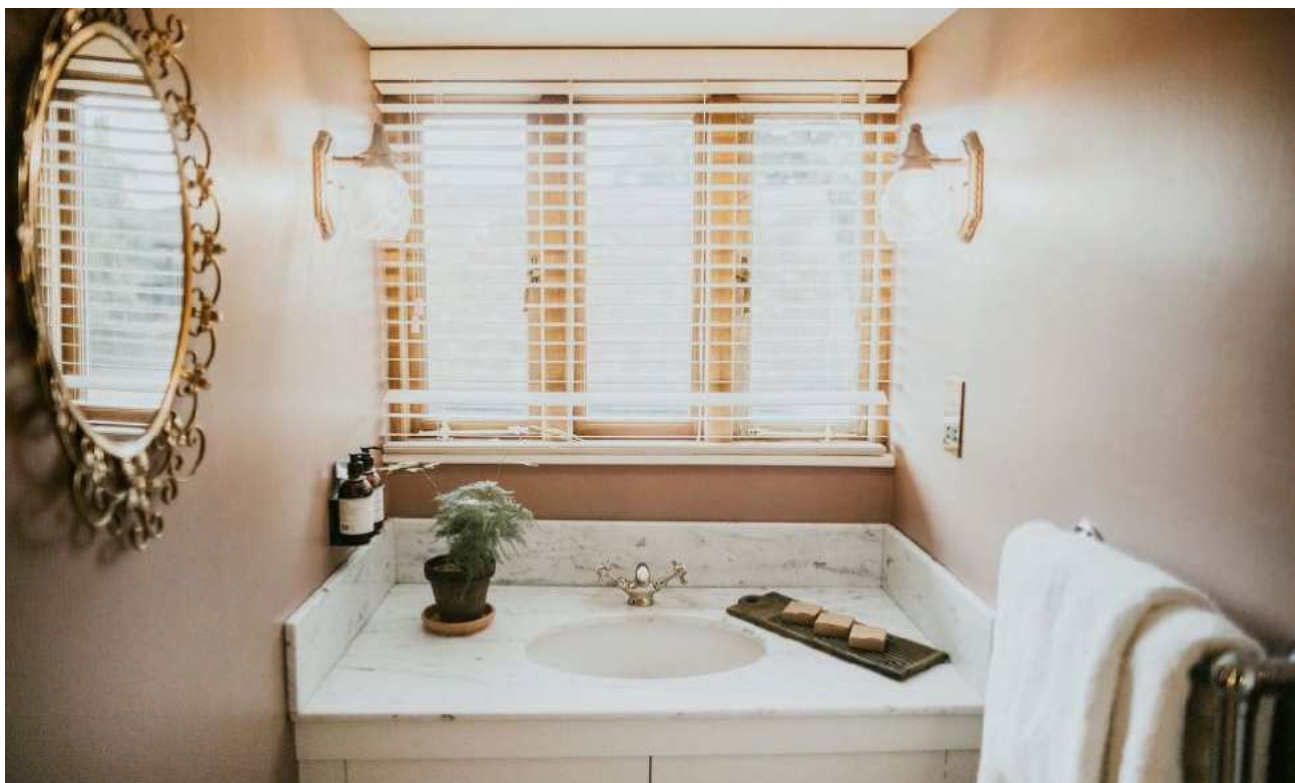
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The elegant and generous en-suite is just a few steps across the hall and flaunts stylish artisan floor tiles, deep blush walls, a shower and delicate brass wall lights.

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Inspiration - at least one room in the house deserved a little old-fashioned chintz with patterned wallpaper, clashing floral fabrics, velvet fringed pendant lamps and impressive antique artwork - The Wheat Room was that room!

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This cosy bedroom features a stunning rattan bed, wood-clad walls and an alcove window seat overlooking the gardens.

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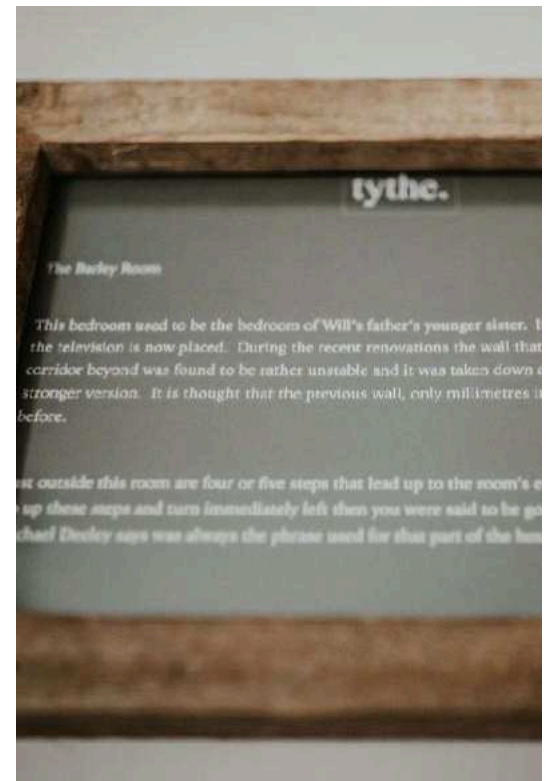
A double built-in wardrobe provides plenty of storage for clothes and shoes and the room is furnished with an eclectic mix of period, antique and more contemporary pieces.

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The ensuite has a fresh, modern feel and is across the hall and up four small steps.

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Inspiration - the gorgeous Jim Lawrence brass wall lights, with their deep blue linen shades, were the starting point for this room and the woollen throws, velvet pillows and sheepskins soon followed!

Large double room, set above The Court Room and spacious enough to accommodate an additional 'put-up' bed and the option to convert to twin beds.



The Oat Room offers a large comfy velvet sofa, coffee table, panelled walls and beautiful high ceilings.

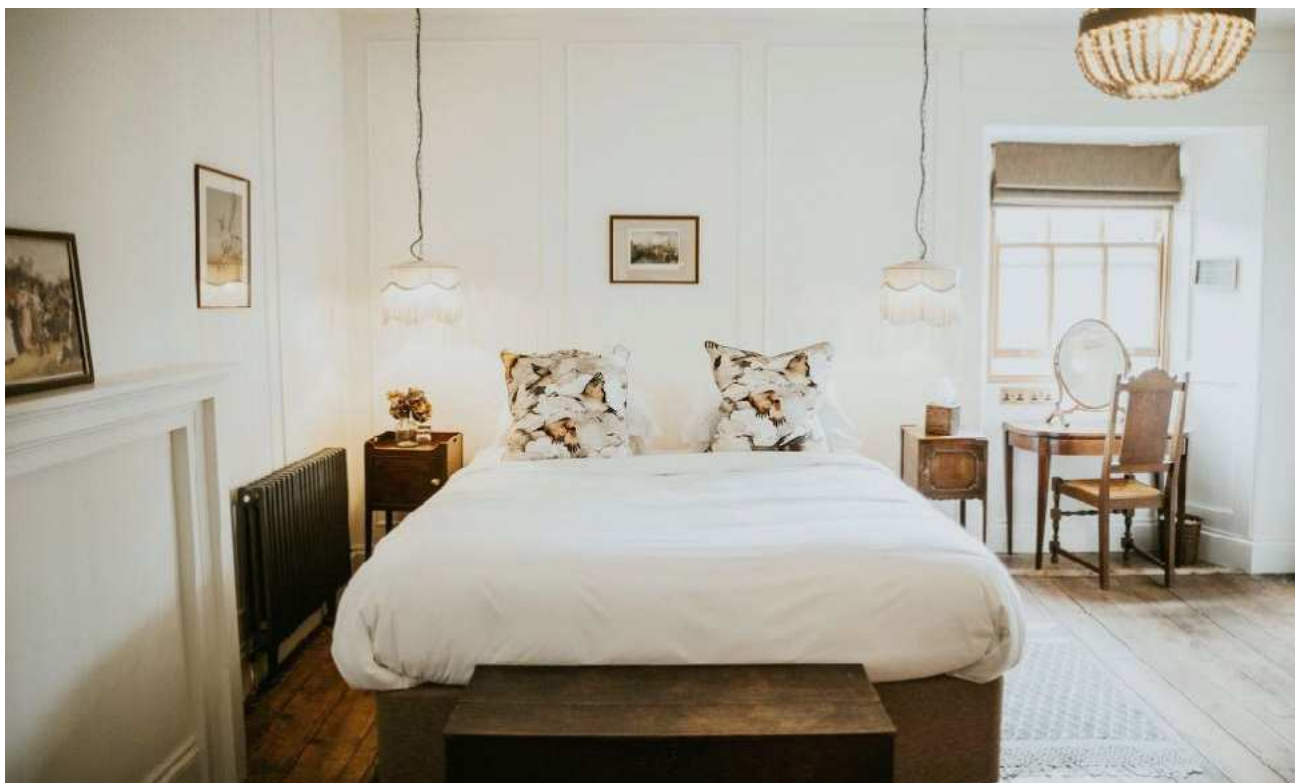


The ensuite boasts both a bath and shower, underfloor heating and gorgeous lighting.



Inspiration - to showcase the impressive high ceilings and gorgeous natural light, delicate panelling was added to the walls and a combination of luxurious velvets and soft woollen fabrics were used to contrast with the aged, old wooden floorboards.

The Attic Room

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Located at the top of the house and up two quirky staircases, The Attic Room boasts some lovely views of the gardens, the 12th Century church next door and the main barn.

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With sloping ceilings and a decadent king size bed - this room has plenty of character! Underfloor heating ensures the room is always cosy whilst chests of drawers and hooks provide ample storage for clothing.

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The ensuite is equally stylish and offers a spacious shower and beautiful patterned floor tiles.

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Inspiration - tucked away at the top of the house, the vaulted ceiling and dormer window inspired the cottage feel and warm, neutral colour palette.

The Cellar Room



On the ground floor and steeped in history, this room is next door to The Court Room and the social spaces of The Lounge and Library are nearby.



The Cellar Room benefits from the original stone walls and fireplace (not in use) and offers a large chest of drawers, armchairs and plenty of hooks for outfits.



The en-suite is often a favourite with guests with the exposed brick, crittall-framed shower and filament bulbs hinting towards industrial interior styling whilst the gilt-framed mirrors add a touch of glamour!



Inspiration - the natural stone, brick and history of The Cellar Room initiated the design process and the styling just evolved from there. Raw, natural, not too fussy is the theme running throughout this bedroom, which as a ground floor room is one of the easiest to access.

The Court Room

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Located at the end of the house, with huge double-aspect windows, this room offers views of the gardens on one side and a glimpse of The Shepherd Hut on the other.

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Boasting character and style, this enormous room has it's own open fireplace, pool table, leather sofa and armchairs, post box and bespoke designed bed that can fold back into the wood-clad walls when the space is better suited to an adult playroom!

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The en-suite is small and functional yet equally stylish. Adjoining the bedroom it offers a shower, loo and basin with antique brass taps.

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Inspiration - Gentleman's Club, through and through. Vintage leather, soft lighting, deep, charcoal walls and red velvet!

Overlooking The Farmhouse gardens and tennis court and set just to the west of the house only a few steps from The Court Room - The Shepherd's Hut offers a cute sleepover for two.



Boasting a double bed complete with woollen throws and sheepskin pillows, mini kitchenette, small table with two chairs and an en-suite shower room - The Shepherd's Hut offers a delightful stay that benefits from the same level of attention to detail seen throughout Tythe but with a huge dose of quirkiness!



Hunker down in the winter with the wood-burner, a hot chocolate and toasty underfloor heating or open up the pretty double wooden doors, grab a seat (discreetly stored beneath the bed) and sit outdoors to soak up the view of the country gardens.



Inspiration - the lambing shelters of years gone by. The hut has been imaginatively designed to offer maximum comfort within minimal space, using traditional materials of timber, copper and tin to create a cosy, romantic retreat whilst being filled with all the creature comforts you would expect for a luxurious stay.





The Shepherd's Hut

The Nook

(only available with select packages)

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Located in a secluded spot, only steps from The Thatched Barn, The Nook provides two light and airy adjoining rooms that overlook it's own private courtyard.

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The impressive, interior-designed spaces feature vaulted ceilings and elegant chandeliers and boast a quirky foldaway bed in the master suite whilst there's space for two further 'put up' beds in the adjacent room.

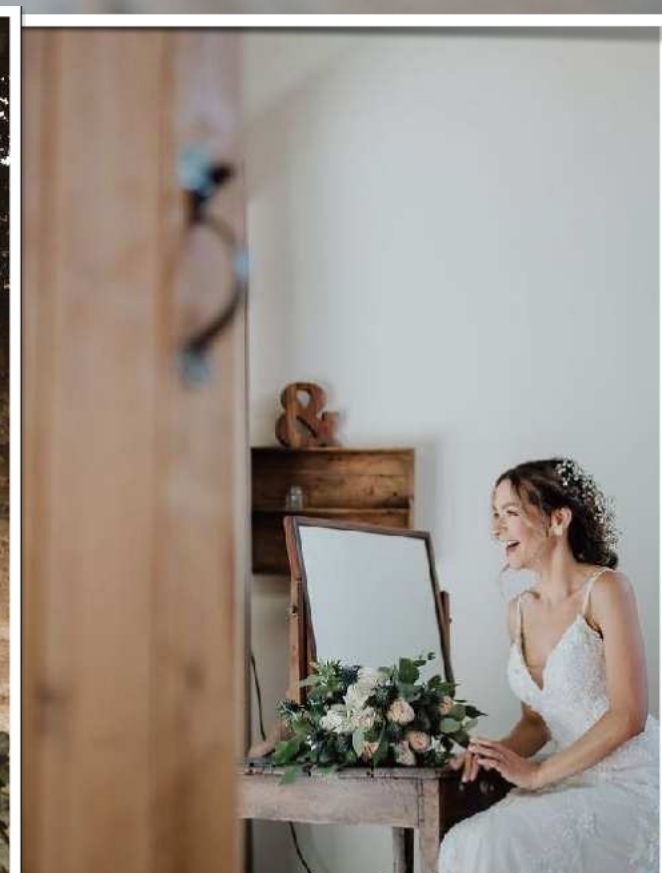
